## Drama Participant & Parent/Guardian Contract

Parkland Immanuel Christian School offers a drama program that seeks to create an environment where students are inspired and challenged to use their God given talents. Participation in this extra-curricular drama program is a privilege. Students wishing to take advantage of the opportunities presented them by Parkland Immanuel Christian School must show a commitment to the drama program by regular attendance at practices and performances, as well as conformity to the rules of the school and the director. Failure to comply with school rules, and/or this contract will result in disciplinary action and/or dismissal from the club.

### Academics

It is recognized that the primary function of the school is to provide each student with an education. Therefore, the principal reserves the right to remove a student from a club if that student is not performing academically as expected. This will only occur after consultation with the student, Director, Producers, teachers, and parents. Signing this form also means that you understand fully the homework room policy as outlined in the Parent Handbook.

### Conduct

Student conduct is a reflection on our school. All participants will strive to ensure their words and actions glorify God and model Christ's love and purpose in their conduct on and off the stage.

- In the academic area, a participant must strive to become a successful student who is productive and responsible in the class. As a participant, you must plan your schedule so that you give sufficient time and energy to your studies to ensure acceptable grades. In addition to maintaining good scholarship, a participant should have a good attendance record, never cutting class or school.
- In practice and performances, a participant is always courteous, makes no excuses, and is respectful to other participants and leadership.
- The participant will be held to the student code of conduct (from school handbook) when representing the school, even if the event is outside of school hours.
- It is the responsibility of the Director and Producers to decide what role each participant will play. If participants or parents have a question regarding this, they will be addressed directly to the Directors and Producer in a mutually acceptable timeframe and in an appropriate, professional manner. If this does not lead to a resolution, the parent can contact the School Administration to discuss the matter further.

Attendance

- Attendance at practices is mandatory. Missing practices may result in removal from club.

Participants will receive a practice schedule in September. Pay careful attention to the schedule; not every participant will be required to attend each practice. There will be one practice a week until December, two practices a week in January, and potential additional rehearsals in January and February until performance on February 22-24. Practices will usually be Mondays (fall) and Mondays and Thursdays (winter).

- If a student is required to miss classes to attend a practice or performance, it is his/her responsibility to contact the teachers of the classes being missed in advance.
- If a participant is absent from school s/he may not participate in any practice or performance on that day.
- If a participant can not make it to a practice or performance, it is their responsibility to contact the Directors well in advance of the practice or game.

Equipment

Costumes will be supplied by the school. The costumes must be submitted promptly after the season ends, cleaned and in good condition. Students may be asked to contribute items to the costume (e.g., white button up shirt or dark socks).

Assumption of Risk

Injury is a risk that must be assumed when engaging in any activity; accordingly, it is acknowledged that the participant assumes the risk of such injury or death and in consideration of the school permitting participation in extra-curricular activities, the student and his/her parents/guardian agree not to hold Parkland Immanuel Christian School liable for any such injury, including death.
